On the second and fourth Tuesdays in the month

7.00 pm to 9.00 pm.

The objective of the Art Group is to bring together like-minded individuals to encourage and help each other to paint. Whilst no formal tuition is currently offered, attempts will be made to obtain this where required and where possible

We are a small group meeting approximately every 2 weeks to help and encourage each other to paint. Whilst the main media we use is watercolour, between us we have knowledge of pastels (normal and oil), watercolour pencils, acrylics and oil (water based), and can provide help and advice on these media in addition to watercolour.

We welcome newcomers whatever their level of expertise, providing help, advice and guidance as and when this is required. This can vary from advice to someone who has never drawn or painted before, to someone having problems with a particular technique, or someone wishing to try a different media. We can recommend books videos/DVDs and even lend these where they are available to us. We can also provide information as to where to get more formal tuition within the immediate area (eg Fareham, Portchester, Stubbington.).

The meetings are split into three sets of sessions through the year – September to December (7 evenings), January to April (8 evenings) and May to July (6 evenings). We make a charge that is just sufficient to cover the cost of the hall, and this is collected at the beginning of each set of sessions. This runs at just under £3.00 an evening (2 hours). Newcomers can attend a two evening tryout, at no charge.
